About SeedVault

Seed phrases are the keys to your digital “vault”, so you need to protect them from physical destruction, as well as from prying eyes!

SeedVault offers you the ultimate physical protection for your seed phrases and passphrases. How do we know, well we punished these devices by torching them until they were "cherry red" so we know they can handle the heat!

Supports BIP39 Mnemonic Seed Phrases

- ✓ *Supports the wallets you own, in the configurations you need.*
- ✓ *12 word seed phrases (e.g. Trezor Model T, Metamask, etc)*
- ✓ *24 word seed phrases (e.g. Ledger & Trezor Devices, Vaulty Wallet*)*
- ✓ *Shamir Secret 20 word seed (e.g. Trezor model T)*
- ✓ *Software and Hardware wallets*
- ✓ *25-50 character passphrases support using Passphrase Plates*
*Vaulty makes use of a seed conversion card to identify words

Expandable and Adaptable Design

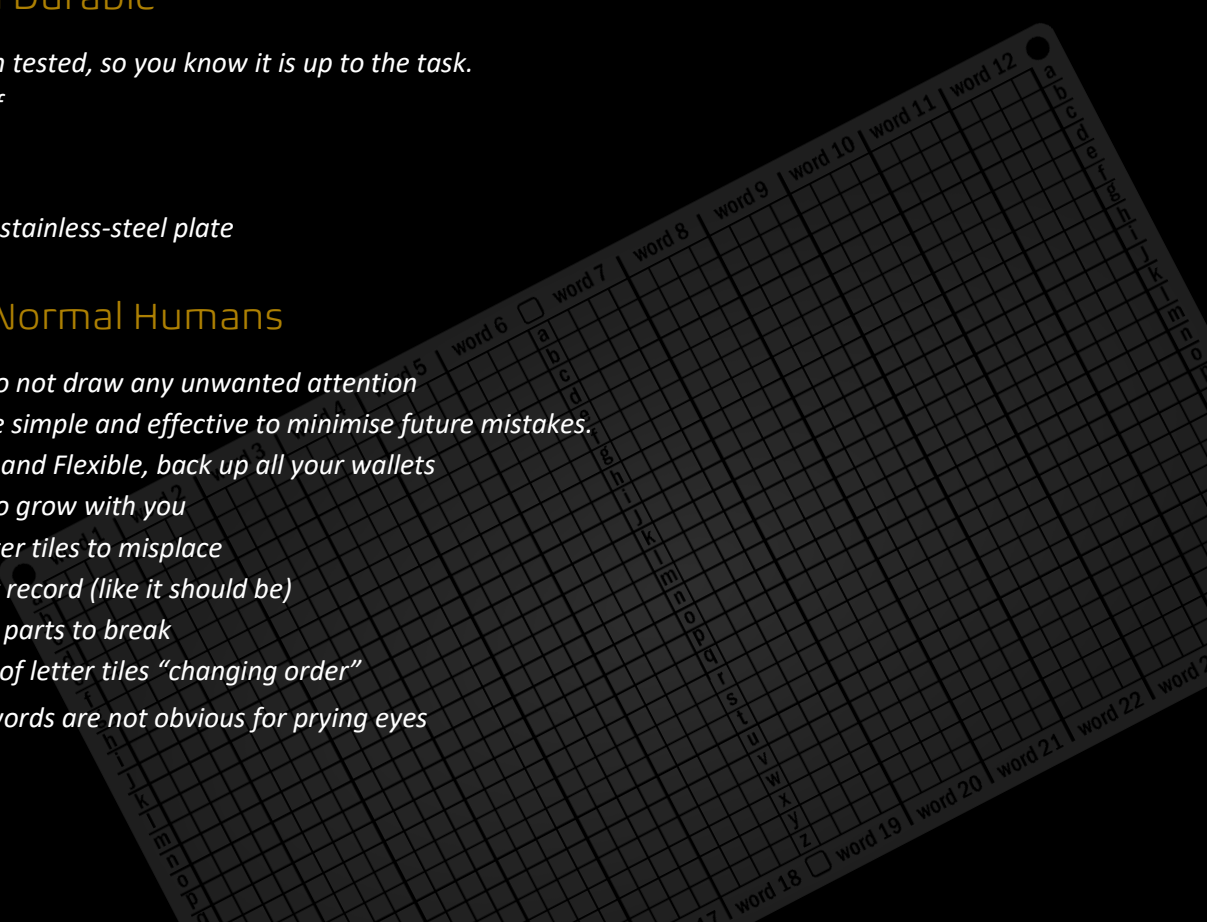
- ✓ *Have multiple seeds you need to back, of course you do!*

- ✓ *No tiny letter tiles to misplace*
- ✓ *Permanent record (like it should be)*
- ✓ *No moving parts to break*
- ✓ *No chance of letter tiles “changing order”*
- ✓ *Coded so words are not obvious for prying eyes*



Step by Step

Allow about 30min to back up a seed or pass phrase, take your time and don't rush. Double and triple check each step.

1. Unpack your Seedvault kit, you should have:
 - a. Two seed or passphrase plates
 - b. Pack of screws
 - c. Tamper proof stickers
 - d. Auto centre-punch
 - e. Permanent marker
 - f. Padded sealable bag
 - g. Helper Card

2. Using the instruction videos and helper sheet found at <https://bradshawknox.com/seedvault/> complete the following steps:
 - 1) Download and fill out the helper sheet.
 - 2) Mark the required letters and numbers on the plate using the permanent marker
 - 3) Double check you have correctly marked the plate, really **DOUBLE CHECK** it!
 - 4) Use the helper card and auto-centre punch to permanently record your seed or passphrase
 - 5) Double check that you have correctly punched ALL squares.

Important Things to Consider

- Make sure you are not in an area with CCTV or webcams (like your computer). If required physically cover webcams with a bit of cloth or paper.
- Physically destroy and un-needed duplicate copies of seed phrase which are not required, including the helper sheet once finished.
- Make sure you shred the helper sheet or any copies of your words and dispose of the shredded pieces in different places i.e. bin, toilet (get creative) etc so that they cannot be brought back together.
- You can keep a copy of your paper seed phrase inside the SeedVault by sandwiching it between the steel plates.



Seed Phrase Plate Helper Sheet

For a **12-word seed phrase** fill out the first 4 letters of each word in the table below.

- if any word only has 3 letters just leave the last square of that word blank

For a **24-word seed phrase** fill out the first 4 letters of each word in the tables below

- if any of the words only has 3 letters just leave the last square of that word blank
- if your seed phrase greater than 12 but less than 24 (e.g. 20), just use the number of extra words required

Remember: if you have a 24-word seed phrase you will be using two seed plates, so it is important you mark the top and bottom box of each plate so you know the order of your seed words. i.e. mark the top box on plate 1 for word 1-12 & mark the bottom box on plate 2 for words 13-24. (see below)

Remember: if you have a greater than 25-character passphrase you will be using two phrase plates, so it is important you mark the box of each plate, so you know the order of your characters.

Example:

1. mark box 1 on plate 1 which indicates characters 1-25
2. mark box 2 on plate 2 which indicates characters 26-50
